



HARTBEAT ENSEMBLE'S YOUTH PLAY INSTITUTE FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS – SPRING 2020

WHAT IS YPI?

HartBeat Ensemble's Youth Play Institute (YPI) is an 8-week paid internship in acting, playwriting, theater design or stage management for young adults between the ages of 16 and 21 years old. In this YPI session, a group of 18 young people will create and perform their own one-act play.

HOW DOES THE PROCESS WORK?

The group is given a broad topic (this session's topic is to be determined) and then conducts research and interviews on the issue. Based on their findings, the group works together to write their play with guidance from HartBeat Teaching Artists. Once the show is written and revised, the casting is done and rehearsals begin. The program culminates with 2 public shows of the group's work. Each performance is followed by a talkback with the audience.

WHEN AND HOW OFTEN DOES YPI MEET?

- There is a mandatory YPI orientation on Saturday, March 7, 10am 1pm.
- The session begins March 10 and meets Tuesday and Thursday from 6-9 for 8 weeks.
- In the final week, there are mandatory rehearsals every evening from 6-9 from Monday November 18 until Friday May 1.
- The Stage Manager is expected to work for an additional half hour each day.
- The shows are on May 2nd and 3rd, with a mandatory wrap-up session on Tuesday, May 5.
- Designers' hours will vary slightly.

WHERE DOES YPI MEET?

At HartBeat's Carriage House Theater at 360 Farmington Ave in Hartford.

WOULD I HAVE TO BE AT EVERY WORKSHOP/REHEARSAL?

Yes! Two pre-arranged absences are allowed if need be. They cannot be during the final week.

HOW MUCH WOULD I GET PAID?

Each intern is paid a stipend of \$60/week. Interns are docked for absences.

DO I HAVE TO BE ENROLLED IN A SCHOOL?

No. Anyone between the ages of 16 and 21 is eligible to try out for YPI.

WHAT KIND OF TRAINING WOULD I RECEIVE?

Although all interns have a part in creating the final show, each intern enters the program as either an actor, set designer, sound designer, costume designer, lighting designer, or stage manager. HartBeat Teaching Artists will train each intern for their specific position.

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WHEN ARE THE INTERVIEWS?

Saturday, February 16 from 6:00pm-9pm and Tuesday, February 18 from 6:00pm-9pm. Other times are available upon request.

WHAT DO I NEED TO PREPARE FOR THE INTERVIEW?

- You should bring a resume if you have one.
- If you're applying for a design position, you can bring a portfolio or some examples of your past work or interest. This can even be magazine pictures that have a design you like. The purpose is simply for you to be able to discuss what interests you about the design position you are applying for.
- Actors do not need to prepare anything.
- ALL applicants (including designers and stage managers) will participate in ensemble activities and improvisations as part of the interview. Please dress in clothing that you feel comfortable moving in.
